






DESIGN FOR A FLOWER HOLDER OR SIMI-LAR ARTICLE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Will Cameron McCartney, a citizen of the United States of America and resident of Cambridge, county of Guernsey, and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Flower Holder or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof, in which—

Figure 1 is a top plan view of a flower holder or similar article, showing my new design;

Figure 2 is a bottom plan view of the same; and

Figure 3 is a side elevational view of the same. The surface of the flower holder is smooth, and the flower receiving apertures are visible through the side since the article is made of transparent material.

I claim-

The ornamental design for a flower holder or similar article, substantially as shown.
