

DESIGN FOR A COMPORT OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

## Term of patent 14 years

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Will Cameron McCartney, a citizen of the United States of America and resident of Cambridge, county of Guernsey, and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Comport or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, in which—

Figure 1 is a side elevational view of a comport showing my new design, the stem and bowl being shown in dotted lines;

Figure 2 is a top plan view of the base of the comport, the stem being shown in dotted lines; and

Figure 3 is a vertical sectional view of the base, a fragmentary portion of the stem being shown in dotted lines.

The characteristic feature of the design resides in the glass base portion of the comport which, due to the concavity of the bottom, presents a bulged appearance when viewed from the top thereof.

I claim—

The ornamental design for a comport or similar article, substantially as shown and described.
