










To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Jess Clair Kelly, a citizen of the United States of America and resident of Cambridge, county of Guernsey and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Combined Cheese and Cracker Tray or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof, in which—

Figure 1 is a top plan view of a combined cheese and cracker tray or similar article, showing my new design;

Figure 2 is a side elevational view of the same; Figure 3 is a top plan view similar to Figure 1 with the cover removed; and

Figure 4 is a vertical sectional view taken on line 4—4, Fig. 3.
