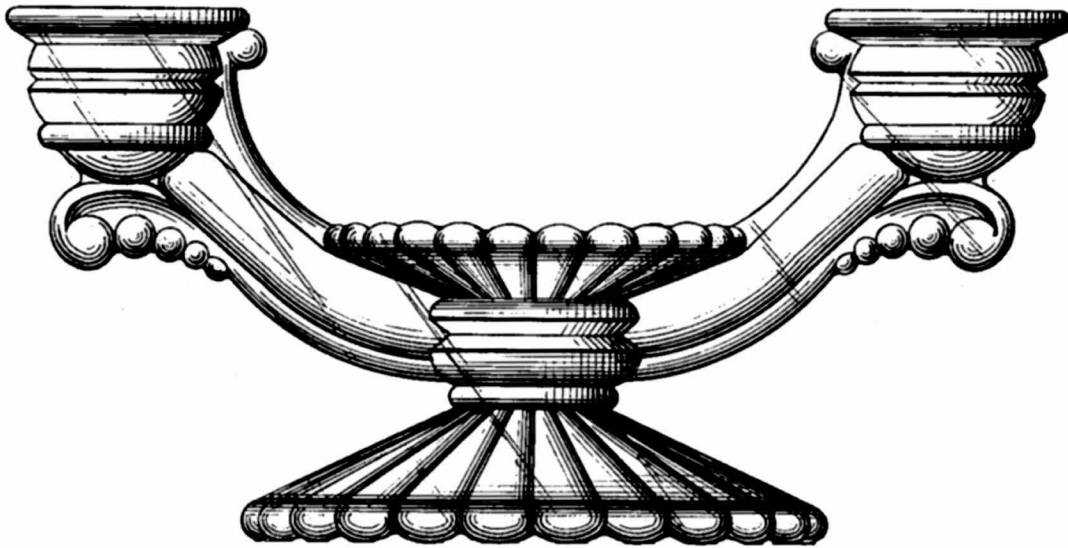
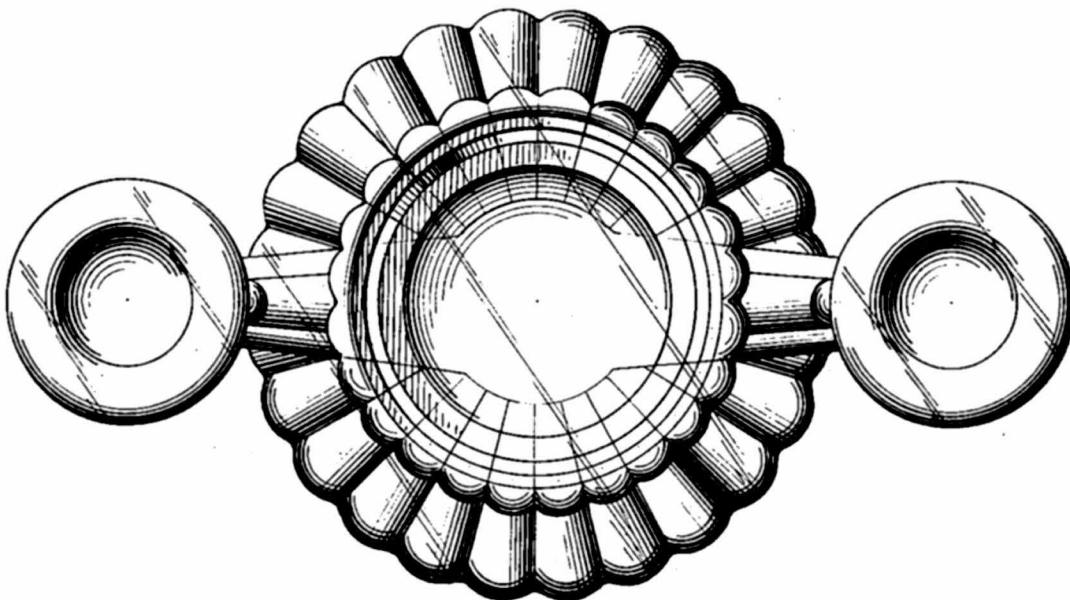

DESIGN FOR A COMBINED CANDLESTICK AND CENTERPIECE OR SIMILAR ARTI- CLE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Jess Clair Kelly, a citizen of the United States of America and resident of Cambridge, county of Guernsey, and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Combined Candlestick and Centerpiece or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, in which—

Figure 1 is a side elevational view of a combined candlestick and centerpiece, showing my new design; and—

Figure 2 is a top plan view of the same.
