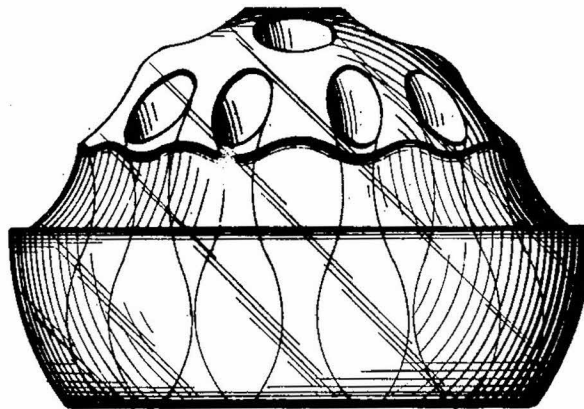
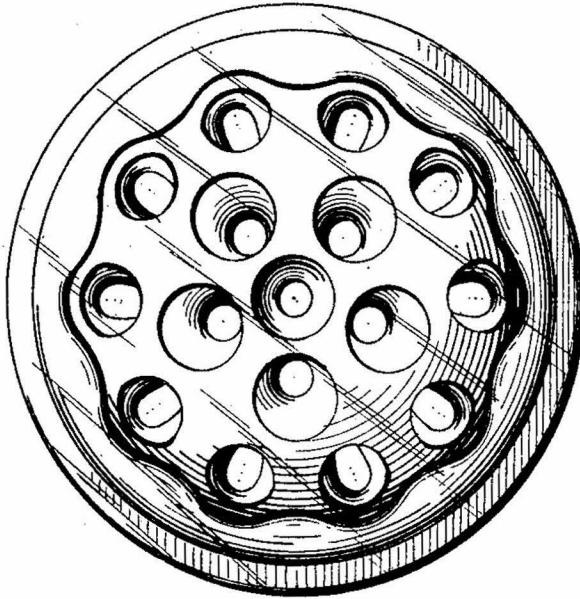

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ARTHUR J. BENNETT, a citizen of the United States, residing at Cambridge, in the county of Guernsey and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Flower-Holder, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a top plan of a flower holder,
