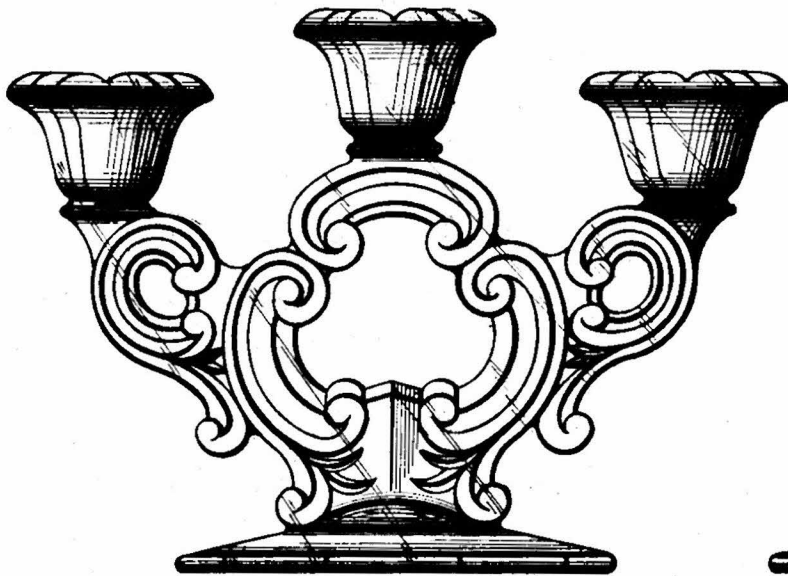

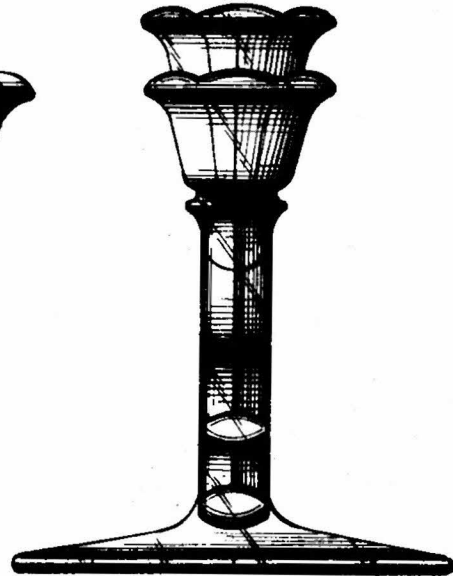
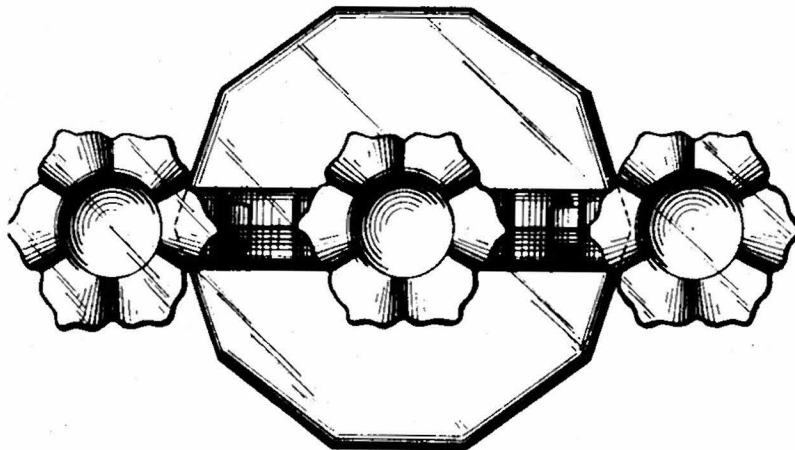

DESIGN FOR A CANDLESTICK.

Application filed January 25, 1929. Serial No. 29,770. Term of patent 3½ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JESS CLAIR KELLY, a citizen of the United States, residing at Cambridge, in the county of Guernsey and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Candlestick, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a front elevation of a candlestick showing my new design;
