



DESIGN FOR A TUMBLER OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ORIE J. Mosser, a citizen of the United States, residing at Cambridge, in the county of Guernsey and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Tumbler or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a side elevation of a tumbler

showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a section on line 2—2 of Fig. 1, and

Fig. 3 is a top plan view.

The dominant feature of the design resides in the surface ornamentation.
