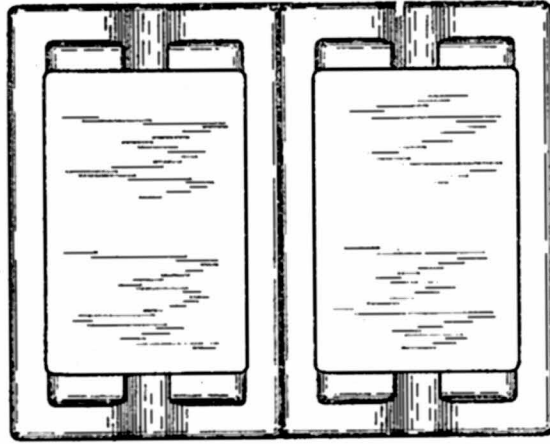

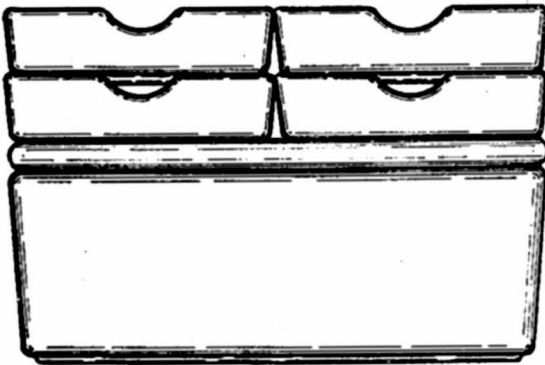

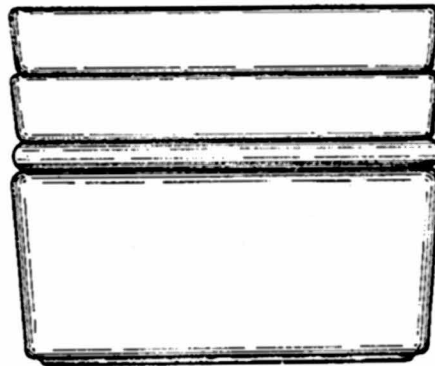
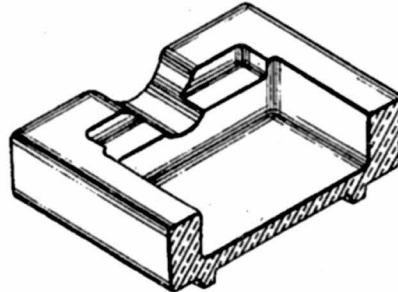

DESIGN FOR A CIGARETTE BOX AND ASH TRAY UNIT

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Will C. McCartney, a citizen of the United States of America and resident of Cambridge, county of Guernsey, and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Cigarette Box and Ash Tray Unit, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, in which—

Figure 1 is a top plan view of a cigarette box and ash tray unit showing my new design;

Figure 2 is a side elevational view of the same;

Figure 3 is an end elevational view of the same;

Figure 4 is a top plan view of the cigarette box with the nested ash trays depicted in Figs. 1, 2 and 3 removed, and

Figure 5 is a fragmentary top perspective view of one of the ash trays.

The ornamental design for a cigarette box and ash tray unit, substantially as shown.
